



## Organist/Choirmaster Position

St. John's Episcopal Church in Olde Towne Portsmouth, Virginia is seeking a part-time organist/choirmaster. Scope of work includes a 10am Sunday Classic Eucharist on alternating Sundays (preceded by a choir rehearsal), Holy Days, and coordination with special musicians for feast day celebrations.

We are looking for someone who will spend an average of 8 hours/month in this ministry. Pay follows AGO compensation guidelines. Weddings and funerals provide additional compensation.

St. John's exceptional Exsultet Organ was created in 2015 by Viscount of Mondaino (Italy). At the time of its installation, which incorporated our existing Austin pipe organ Opus 2171, it was Viscount's largest instrument in North America. It features over 70 stops with a triple keyboard French console inspired by Aristide Cavallé-Coll on a movable performance platform. Jeremy Filsell (organist & director of music, St. Thomas Church, NYC) and Daniel Roth (emeritus titular organist, Church of St. Sulpice, Paris) have performed notable concerts on this beautiful instrument.

St. John's Church has a firm belief in diverse worship and offers a Contemplative (said) Eucharist at 8am each week as well as Classic and Contemporary Eucharists at 10am on alternating Sundays. Through the music we offer, our goal is to draw people into a deeper relationship with God in Jesus Christ. With the departure of our current musician after a stellar nine-year ministry, we look with hope to see who God will next call to this vital role in our parish life.
